Summary

- Important guidance!
 - “...the utility of modeling for country-level decision-making is greatly influenced by how it is integrated into the process of policy identification and comparison.” (p. 5)
- Principle 8: Timeliness
 - “Modelling should fit into the policy and planning cycle”
 - 8.1: correct cycle, including time for review/revision of both assumptions and scenarios

Comments

- Value of integrating modeling into policy-making process
 - Shadowing of GF negotiating mission in TZ
 - HIV: AIM (AEM) files underpinning, especially Performance Framework (M&E)
- Lessons from HIV
 - Harmonized list of interventions
 - Regular estimates workshops
 - Country participation/buy-in process
 - Linked with planning cycles (GF?)
 - Perhaps piggybacked onto the (now institutionalized) HIV estimates workshops for epidemiological part
